Old Business:

 - ii. Monika Cotter will ask as many food trucks as possible to come out and sell.
 - iii. Since the event is relatively new, vendor and food truck slots will be free.
 - iv. Committee will use their own speakers for music
 - v. Abigail Long will offer a \$5 family photo with a picnic backdrop.
 - vi. Have 8 game/activity stations.
 - vii. One feature event will be advertised with a reward for the winners (ex. Tug of war).
 - viii. Committee will use the email chain to find volunteers to man stations.
 - ix. Dr Kenjuana McCray advises that the Special Events Committee will need to be involved if a beer garden is added onto this event.
 - x. Destiny Kendall asks about shade tents throughout the area.
 - xi. Chancer McLaughlin will investigate tents for the committee to purchase for future events.
 - xii. Until then, the committee will collect 10x10 tents to borrow.
 - xiii. Destiny Kendall recommends using Fort Bragg MWR rentals for any tables and tents that the committee might need.
 - xiv. Family Fun Day will promote the adopt a school and any upcoming networking events.
 - xv. Monika Cotter will reach out to the Parks and Rec Department for a jumpy pillow and petting zoo rental.
 - xvi. Allison Rogers will create the flyer for this event.
 - xvii. to fund the stage rental and entertainment
