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TOWN OF HOPE MILLS PROJECT UPDATES

TOWN OF HOPE MILLS MUNICIPAL PROJECTS

Hope Mills Lake Parking Lot: Parks and Recreation Staff is currently working through design options for the expansion of parking at Hope Mills Lake. The expanded parking will include the 2 recently acquired lots at the corner of Fountain Lane and Hope Mills Road.



Reid's Journey: Parks and Recreation Staff has officially opened use of the Liberty Swing inside the Reid's Journey All Inclusive Playground. The liberty swing is one of the only swings in this region for children in wheelchairs.



TOWN OF HOPE MILLS RESIDENTIAL PROJECTS

Sweetwater Subdivision: The next phase of single family residential development is underway in the Sweetwater Subdivision. This community is located off of Elk Road and is in the 2nd phase of development.



The One Apartments: This multi-family residential development is also located off of Elk Road directly across from the Sweetwater Subdivision. Construction is well underway for over 300+ apartment units.



The Reserve at Traemoor: This multi-family residential development is located within the Traemoor Village mixed used development. Phase 1 is under construction for over 70+ apartments.





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TOWN OF HOPE MILLS PROJECT UPDATES CONT.

TOWN OF HOPE MILLS COMMERCIAL PROJECTS

Dirtbag Plaza: The Dirtbag Ales development is well underway with their commercial project directly adjacent to the existing brewery. This 6 acre site is proposed for over 7 shops that include a 6,000+ square foot sit down restaurant.



WaWa's Travel Center: The Town of Hope Mills' first WaWa's service station is currently under construction. The travel center which is a prototype for WaWa's, will also provide for a significant amount of overnight commercial truck parking.



Frito-Lay Distribution: The certificate of occupancy has been granted for the new Frito-Lay Distribution Center. Located 5080 US 301 S, this 11 acre site will bring jobs as well as an industrial presence to Hope Mills.



NCDOT PROJECT UPDATE: GOLVIEW AND ROCKFISH RD

Fred Smith & Co has been selected as the general contractor for the widening of Rockfish and Golfview Roadways. There will be preliminary surveys and some signage possible with an immediate start in some areas. Start date is currently set for May 1, 2025 with a completion date set for March 29, 2028.



Standard workday operations will be from 9:00 AM – 3:00 PM with the contractor coordinating extended and night hours as needed. Staff will coordinate decorative fence removal at the ponds next to the library and the lay down yard for the project will be located at the rear of the Hope Mills Golf Course. Driveways are designed to be poured with high early strength concrete.

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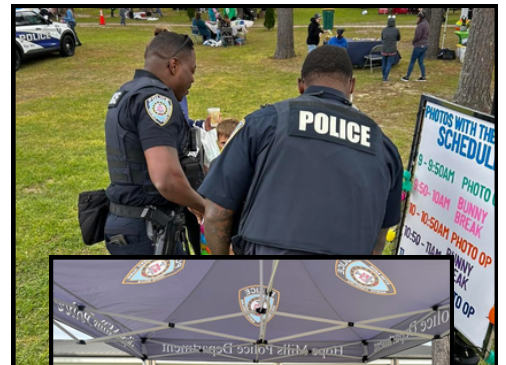
