The restored flume, which is the main focal element of the park, consists of the historic preservation of the historic old mill flume, and the conversion of the flume to a stormwater control measure that treats the new impervious surfaces constructed in the park.

Heritage Park includes a new driveway, restroom, parking lot, event lawn, and the preservation and placement of the floodgates as shade canopies over benches. Additionally, there are interpretive signs that explain the history of the Town, the mill, and how the flume has been repurposed to treat
