NORTH CAROLINA LEAGUE OF MUNICIPALITIES CITYVISION 2024 CONFERENCE

The 2024 National League of Municipalities 2024 CityVision Conference was held on April 23-25 in Winston Salem, NC. Considered the “City of Arts and Innovation”, the conference provided municipalities and cities across the state with the opportunity to network, learn, and grow together.

For the first time, the League offered education credits for attendance at the CityVision session through its Advancing Municipal Leaders Certification Program.

EDUCATION SESSIONS:

Planning Partnerships: This session centered around lessons learned by both client and consultant over the past 40-plus years that have resulted in best practices employed prior to preparing for an RFQ or RFP all the way through project implementation.

Dont Go Viral: This session examined the First Amendment rights concerning citizens and municipal staff.

Municipal Case Study - Improved Budget Process in Indian Trail: In 2021 the Town of Indian Trail completely revamped and overhauled their budget process. Digitizing their process resulted in increased transparency, updated systems, and a new improved approach to budgeting.

Trails: An Economic Driver for NC Cities and Towns: Session centered around how towns can successfully benefit from developing and enhancing these community assets.

TOWN OF HOPE MILLS PROJECTS and ACTIVITIES

HOPE MILLS PARKS AND RECREATION UPDATE:

Construction is still ongoing for the upgrades to Field #2 for the Hope Mills Rockfish Baseball Team which includes the new press box.



Construction has begun for the completion of a new parking lot to service the Veteran's Memorial Park on the Hope Mills Complex. The project is being managed by the Parks and Recreation Department. The parking lot contemplates the installation of 25 parking spaces with 2 ADA accessible spaces and 5 reserved for veterans .

HOPE MILLS FIRE DEPARTMENT UPDATE

The Hope Mills Fire Department has responded to a total of 643 incidents to date and has completed a total of 520 hours of training. Our Fire Marshall has completed a total of 15 inspections for the month of March along with 49 pre-fire plans and has issued a total of 8 citations.

HOPE MILLS PUBLIC WORKS UPDATE

Public Works staff is continuing the management of the reconstruction of the multi-use path at Hope Mills Lake. The total cost of the project is \$499,200 with a 20% match to be paid by the Town of Hope Mills. Total cost incurred to date on the project is \$44,238.
