TOWN OF HOPE MILLS PROJECTS and ACTIVITIES

HOPE MILLS PUBLIC WORKS UPDATE:

NEW PARKING LOT: Public works staff is currently working towards a concept and scope for the paving of the dirt parking lot near the All Inclusive Playground that has access provided off of Golfview Road. Possible funding would come from the Hope Mills Stormwater Department.

FAMPO SIDEWALKS: The Town of Hope Mills has been awarded \$699,999 dollars from the Fayetteville Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (FAMPO) for the installation of sidewalks along Cameron Road beginning at S. Main Street. The proposed project will provide much needed pedestrian access routes for Hope Mills Middle School.

HOPE MILLS PARKS AND RECREATION UPDATE:

Parks and recreation staff is currently managing the installation of a picnic shelter tied to Phase 2 of the Reids Journey All Inclusive Playground. Picnic benches will also be installed with the possibility of new grills as well. Part of Phase 2 also includes the installation of a wheel chair swing which will be the first of its kind in this region.

CGI DIGITAL UPDATE:

CGI Digital recently released a promo video with the Town Manager advertising a branding program for the Town of Hope Mills. This will be an update to the program that began 4 years ago that provided citizens with valuable information on the quality of life, projects, and valuable assets in the Town of Hope Mills. Staff will be coordinating with them over the next few months to finalize the branding program which is set to be completed with the rollout of the new Hope Mills website.
